A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES CONTROL GRANT


WHEREAS, Delavan Lake is an important resource used by the public for recreation and enjoyment of natural beauty; and
WHEREAS, public use and enjoyment of Delavan Lake is best served by the protection of Delavan Lake from infestation of aquatic invasive species; and
WHEREAS, we recognize the need to provide information or education about aquatic invasive species; and
WHEREAS, we are qualified to carry out the responsibilities of an aquatic invasive species control project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Town of Delavan requests grant funding and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "Aquatic Invasive Species Control Grant Program" and hereby authorizes the Administrator to act on behalf of the Town of Delavan to:


1. Submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for aquatic aquatic invasive species control purposes.
2. Sign documents.
3. Take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete an approved aquatic invasive species control grant
4. Submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation within six months of the project completion date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Town of Delavan will meet obligations of the aquatic invasive species control project including timely publication of the results and meet the financial obligations of an aquatic invasive species grant, including prompt payment of our 50% commitment to aquatic invasive species control project costs.
