RESOLUTION TOWN OF DELAVAN

9-1-1 Emergency Number System
To Supersede Resolution Adopted Jan. 20, 1981

WHEREAS, CHAPTER 146 of Wisconsin State Statutes requires that all public agencies including municipalities implement a basic "9-1-1" emergency number system by December 31, 1987; and

WHEREAS, by March 31, 1980, and every year thereafter until the "9-1-1" plan is fully implemented, progress reports must be provided to the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town of Delavan to designate a "9-1-1" planning co-ordinator, and whereas it is deemed necessary that a planning co-ordinator be appointed by the Town Board of the Town of Delavan, Wisconsin, to work with this "9-1-1" emergency number system to implement a town wide program; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Delavan and the City of Delavan have agreed to utilize a "9-1-1" emergency number system for their entire 728 telephone exchange area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Delavan, Walworth County, Wisconsin, do hereby adopt a Town of Delavan "9-1-1" emergency number system program, said system to be operational as soon as possible and that the Chief of Police be and hereby is appointed as planning co-ordinator, who shall report periodically to said Town Board and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Delavan 728 exchange - in conjunction with the City of Delavan 728 exchange will have a "9-1-1" emergency number system with the primary public safety answering point (PSAP) located at the Sheriffs Department in Elkhorn, Wisconsin, and with the secondary or backup public safety answering point (PSAP) located at the Police Department in the City of Delavan. The Sheriffs Department will be directly connected to the City of Delavan by the same line utilizing an intercom system and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the remaining telephone exchanges within Delavan Township of 723 (which has the "9-1-1" capability now) and 245 utilize the "9-1-1" service with their respective exchanges. Also those areas of Darien, Richmond and Sugar Creek Townships with the 728 exchange will be included in our "9-1-1" plan and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said "9-1-1" emergency number system comply with chapter 146 laws 1977 and the Wisconsin Telephone Co. provide said "9-1-1" service to the entire 728 exchange and to act as the principal in this matter, in seeing all required telephone lines and that, that equipment which is necessary to make this "9-1-1" system operational are provided.
