WHEREAS Delavan Lake is an important resource used by the public for recreation and enjoyment of natural beauty; and

WHEREAS the protection of the Inlet, Main Lake and Outlet areas are paramount in the protection of the water quality and the natural ecosystem of the lake; and

WHEREAS the Town of Delavan is qualified to carry out the responsibilities of these Lake Planning Projects;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

The Town of Delavan requests the funds and assistance available for the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "Lake Planning Grant Program" and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES June E. Yantis to act on behalf of the Town of Delavan to: submit the applications to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for lake planning purposes; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete an approved lake planning project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Town of Delavan will comply with state rules for the program, may perform force account work and will meet the financial obligations under the grants.
