TOWN OF DELAVAN, WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN

RESOLUTION FOR LAKE MANAGEMENT PLANNING GRANT

WHEREAS, Delavan Lake is an important resource used by the public for recreation and enjoyment of natural beauty; and

WHEREAS, the protection of critical watershed areas and reasonable lake use activities are paramount in the protection of water quality and the natural ecosystem of the lake; and

WHEREAS, we are qualified to carry out the responsibilities of a restoration project which includes native plant stock or seeds for re-establishing vegetation, labor costs, professional services and construction materials in connection with such a project

IT IS, THEREFORE, RESOLVED THAT:

The Town of Delavan requests the funds and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "Lake Management Planning Grant Program", a program that provides grants of \$10,000 and does not require cost share: and


HEREBY AUTHORIZES the Town Chair to act on behalf of the Town of Delavan to: submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for lake planning purposes, to wit: to defray a portion of the engineering costs in connection with the Mound Road Sedimentation Pond Project; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete an approved restoration project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Delavan will comply with state rules for the program, will secure all necessary water regulatory and wetland permits at the time of application required by the grant guidelines.


