

RESOLUTION #18-2009

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND CHAPTER 11.11 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Town of Delavan has previously voted to increase dog licensing fees partly due to increased fees charged by Walworth County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Delavan, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does hereby resolve to amend Chapter 11.11 of the Town of Delavan Municipal Code in its' entirety as follows:

11.11 DOG LICENSING AND REGULATION.

(31) DOG LICENSES REQUIRED. No person shall own, harbor or keep any dog more than 6 months of age without complying with the provisions of Secs. 174.05 through 174.09, Wis. Stats., relating to the listing, licensing and tagging of dogs.

(a) Dog License Fees: Fees shall be established as follows:

(i)	Altered Male:	\$ 10.00
(ii)	Altered Female:	\$ 10.00
(iii)	Unaltered Male:	\$ 20.00
(iv)	Unaltered Female:	\$ 20.00
(v)	Kennel	\$ 35.00
(vi)	Special instance	\$ 8.00

Above listed fees will be paid to the Town Treasurer, due and payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January each license year.

(32) NUMBER OF DOGS LIMITED. Unless otherwise licensed as a kennel, no person shall keep more than four dogs on their premises at one time, except litters of pups under six months of age.
