

Resolution of TOWN OF DELAVAN

County of WALWORTH

Whereas DELAVAN Lake is an important resource used by the public for recreation and enjoyment of natural beauty; and

Whereas the natural integrity of the lake's ecosystem is treated by the exotic nuisance aquatic weed, Eurasian Water Milfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*); and

Whereas a study and evaluation of naturally occurring biological control agents (aquatic insects) will lead to better understanding of control techniques for management of Eurasian Water Milfoil; and

Whereas we recognize the need for responsible and holistic long-range planning to better manage the lake and its aquatic plants, its watershed and its use; and

Whereas we are qualified to carry out the responsibilities of this lake management planning project

**IT IS, THEREFORE, RESOLVED THAT:**

TOWN OF DELAVAN requests the funds and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "Lake Planning Project Grant Program" and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** TOWN OF DELAVAN will meet the obligations of the planning project including timely publication of the results and meet the financial obligations under this grant including the prompt payment of our 25% cash commitment to the project costs. We also understand the proposed study is experimental in nature and may not provide control results.

We understand the importance of a continuing lake management program for DELAVAN Lake and intend to proceed on that course.
