

PROPOSED WALWORTH COUNTY LAND INFORMATION SYSTEM PLAN
IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT NO. 7

(LARGE-SCALE TOPOGRAPHIC MAPPING FOR THE
NORTHERN ONE-HALF OF TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 16 EAST)

WHEREAS, Walworth County has created a Land Information Office pursuant to the requirements of Wis. Stats. § 59.88; and

WHEREAS, The Walworth County Board has designated its Register of Deeds as the official contact person for the Walworth County Land Information Office; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 59-10/91, the Walworth County Board adopted the Walworth County plan for land records modernization as set forth in SEWRPC Community Assistance Planning Report No. 139, A Land Information System Plan for Walworth County; and

WHEREAS, there are State grants-in-aid available from the Wisconsin Land Information Board to assist in the implementation of the above-referenced Plan; and

WHEREAS, the above-referenced Walworth County Plan for land records modernization recommends that Walworth County seek grants from the Wisconsin Land Information Board in support of activities relating to completion of a county-wide automated base map; and

WHEREAS, the grant application procedures promulgated by the Wisconsin Land Information Board require that all applications for grants-in-aid, including those submitted jointly with, or entirely by, local units of government, must be submitted under the authority and act of the County Board. Moreover, in the event of local government participation, grant applications must be submitted under the authority and act of the local governmental unit's governing body pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 16.967(7) and Adm. 47.04 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has established a July 1995 filing period during which the County and local units of government through the County are eligible to apply for a State land information system development grant-in-aid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Delavan supports the joint submittal with Walworth County, the City of Delavan, and the City of Elkhorn of an application to the Wisconsin Land Information Board for a State grant in the amount of \$51,150 in support of digital topographic mapping as described in said application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Chairman is authorized to act on behalf of the Town of Delavan as the designated representative in connection with any State grant that may be awarded as a result of the aforementioned grant application.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
