

RESOLUTION NO. 4.2008
TOWN OF DELAVAN, COUNTY OF
WALWORTH, STATE OF WISCONSIN
Date: June 17, 2008

WHEREAS, the Town of Delavan is desirous of facilitating a water skiing exhibition as part of its Independence Day celebration; and

WHEREAS, said exhibition is likely to create a violation of certain provisions of the Town of Delavan Municipal Code regarding lake use; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and appropriate to temporarily suspend the enforcement of certain lake use restrictions for the purposes of allowing said water skiing exhibition to proceed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Delavan, as follows:

1. The Town Board of the Town of Delavan, Walworth County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve that on June 28, 2008 from 12:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m., that actual participants in the water skiing exhibition to take place on or near the Town of Delavan park shall be excepted from enforcement of the provisions of Chapter 19 of the Town of Delavan Municipal Code.

2. The foregoing moratorium on enforcement shall apply only to actual participants in said exhibition and only during the foregoing hours on the date stated herein.

3. Nothing herein shall preclude the enforcement of such provisions of the Town of Delavan Municipal Code that are designed to prevent death or great bodily harm as the result of the use of Delavan Lake.
