WHEREAS, the Turtle Creek watershed has been designated as a "priority watershed" under the State of Wisconsin Nonpoint Source Water Pollution Abatement Program, and,

WHEREAS, the majority of the lands within in the Town of Delavan are located within the Turtle Creek watershed, and,


WHEREAS, the Town of Delavan has adopted a Land Use Plan for the Town in which part of its goals and objectives are the abatement of non-point source water pollution, and

WHEREAS, a plan has been prepared to abate water pollution from non-point sources within the Turtle Creek watershed.
