WHEREAS, the Walworth County Board of Supervisors has proposed and adopted a text change to the Walworth County Shoreland Zoning Ordinance; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Delavan does believe that the proposed text change is one that will benefit water quality in Delavan Lake and other lakes in Walworth County.




