

**RESOLUTION #5-2008**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Delavan has previously adopted a Preliminary Resolution regarding the dredging of Brown's Channel in the Town of Delavan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Delavan has received an engineer's report of said project; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing regarding a proposed special assessment for the benefits conferred herein was held upon due and proper legal notice; and

**WHEREAS**, after said hearing, the Town Board of the Town of Delavan has determined that it is necessary to modify the proposed special assessment so as to more equitably and fairly assess the benefits conferred by this project.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Town Board of the Town of Delavan, Walworth County, Wisconsin, as follows:

1. The owners of property as set forth subsequently herein will have received a special benefit by virtue of the work performed on Brown's Channel.

2. Each owner of land as set forth in the exhibits annexed hereto shall have the amounts set forth herein levied against each parcel denominated herein.

3. The amount specially assessed herein may be paid in full on or before January 31, 2009, without interest. Payments received subsequent to January 31, 2009, shall bear interest in the rate of 5.0% per annum retroactive to the date of the adoption of this resolution, until paid in full.

4. In the event the owners of the parcels set forth herein elect not to pay the amounts of the special assessment in full on or before January 31, 2009, the amount specially assessed shall be due in ten equal installments, together with interest at the rate of 5.0% per annum retroactive to the date of the adoption of this resolution, until paid in full.

5. The Clerk shall cause this final resolution to be published as a Class I Notice.

6. The Clerk shall send a copy of this Final Resolution to every interested person whose post office address is known or can be ascertained with reasonable diligence.
