

RESOLUTION NO. 17

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD
OF THE TOWN OF DELAVAN
WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is considering a proposal which would allow a revision in town laws that towns may withdraw from county zoning if electors approve it at a town meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Delavan has adopted village powers and has created a town plan commission, and

WHEREAS, the town plan commission presently reviews and provides recommendations on zoning to the county, and

WHEREAS, from time to time the county zoning has not been consistent or in the best interests of the Town of Delavan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Delavan supports changes in town laws which will allow towns to withdraw from county zoning provided the town adopts a zoning ordinance that is at least as restrictive as the present county zoning ordinance.
