NOW, THEREFORE, It Is hereby Resolved as follows:

That the Town Board of the Town of Delavan is opposed to the proposed siting of the greyhound dog track in the City of Delavan supported by the receipt of 2,055 signatures of residents of the Town of Delavan as well as signatures of 797 residents of the City of Delavan and 303 signatures of residents of Southern Wisconsin;


That the Wisconsin Racing Board cause a traffic study to be done on Highway 50, County Trunks "F" north and south, North Shore Drive, Linn Road, Borg Road and South Shore Drive;

That the Wisconsin Racing Board cause an environmental impact study to be done for the potential water runoff and drainage into the pond behind the K-Mart shopping mall, Swan Creek and Delavan Lake;


That the Wisconsin Racing Board contact Delavan Township officials and department heads and hold a public hearing regarding the safety, welfare and health of the residents of the Town of Delavan;

That the Wisconsin Racing Board complete the traffic study, environmental impact study, confer with public officials and department heads in the Town of Delavan and hold a public hearing before a decision is made on the location of a greyhound dog track in the City of Delavan.
