

RESOLUTION #14-2009

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING LANDSCAPE RESTORATION THROUGH AN AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES CONTROL GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, Delavan Lake is an important resource used by the public for recreation and enjoyment of natural beauty; and

**WHEREAS**, Delavan Lake is best served by protection from infestation of the aquatic invasive species Yellow Floating Heart; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Delavan recognizes the need to complete the landscape restoration following the dredging of the Geneva Landings Stormwater Ponds to help eradicate the species and prevent spreading to Delavan Lake; and

**WHEREAS**, we are qualified to carry out the responsibilities and requirements of this Aquatic Invasive Species Control Project.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Town of Delavan requests grant funding and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "Aquatic Invasive Species Control Grant Program" and hereby authorizes the Town Chair to act on behalf of the Town of Delavan to:

1. Submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for aquatic invasive species control purposes.
2. Sign documents.
3. Take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete an approved aquatic invasive species control grant
4. Submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation within six months of the project completion date.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the Town of Delavan and Geneva Landings will meet the obligations of the dredging project including timely publication of the results and coordinating the financial obligations of this grant program. The matching dollar requirement will be the sole responsibility of Geneva Landings.
