RESOLUTION NO 18.

WHEREAS, IT is in the interest of the Municipal Government of the Town of Delavan, Walworth County, Wisconsin to monitor the impact of legislative and judicial actions on the public dollar and,

WHEREAS, the decision of the Supreme Court of the United States in the case of Garcia vs. San Antonio Metropolitan Transit Authority will have an immediate and adverse impact on all level of governmental agencies and,

WHEREAS, the inclusion of State and Local Governmental bodies and their respective sub-divisions under the Fair Labor Standards Act will create a burden of millions of dollars on the taxpayers of said governmental agencies

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a suitable copy of this resolution be transmitted to both legislative bodies of the Congress of the State of Wisconsin and the Congress of the United States of America and to the President of the United States of America; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that members of all local municipalities of the State of Wisconsin, United States of America be urged to forward copies of this resolution to their respective Congressmen and Senators with a personal request to respond to this significant problem.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE TOWN OF DELAVAN, WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN DOES HEREBY SUPPORT THE INTRODUCTION OF SENATE BILL S1570 AND SIMILAR LEGISLATION IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO REVERSE SAID DECISION OF THE UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT AND TO EXEMPT SAID GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES FROM THE PROVISIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF THE FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT.
