WHEREAS, Town of Delavan residents were cruelly reminded of the dedication, commitment, and honor each of our "first responders" brings to his or her job, and


WHEREAS, the residents of the Town of Delavan are humbled by the fierce sense of loss and love our departments have shown for their fallen brethren, and

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Delavan Town Board does adopt and publish Resolution #133, this 18th day of September, 2001.


