WHEREAS, the protection on critical watershed areas and reasonable lake use activities are paramount in the protection of water quality and the natural ecosystem of the lake;
and

WHEREAS, we are qualified to carry out the responsibilities of this protection project;

IT IS, THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:
The Town of Delavan requests the funds and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "Lake Protection Grant Program"; and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES, June Yantis to act on behalf of the Town of Delavan to: submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for lake protection purposes; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete an approved lake protection project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT The Town of Delavan will comply with State rules for the program, may perform force account work and will meet the financial obligations under the grant.
