WHEREAS, this formal letter of dedication is on file with the Town Clerk, for said Town of Delavan, and



Delavan Lake Acres Partnership agrees to grant to Delavan Township a new temporary easement over its property from Borg Road to the dam for the purposes of maintaining and servicing the outlet dam.

This temporary easement would be in the form of a temporary road over the existing Delavan Lake Sanitary District easement located south of the creek.

At any time in the future, Delavan Lake Acres Partnership, or their successors in interest, may withdraw this easement thereby requiring the Township to service the dam over its present easement north of the creek or through a new easement which may be granted by Delavan Lake Acres Partnership in the future.
